- 1) **Speeding:** Two complaints from Security, on the west side, passing cars w/no room. **This is the LAST warning**....more severe action will be taken.
- 2) We have had a couple **of problems with the apparatus'** having dead batteries: Engine 845 and Support 843. Be sure that you turn everything off and that 845 is plugged in good.
- 3) **When the Engine goes out.** Tender 848 goes out with it for ALL structure fires. Tender 840 and Tender 841 will be used for nursing Tender 848
- 4) **If you are hurt on an** incident, report it and go to the doctor within 48 hours. This is the procedure for the insurance company. Bill is the liaison between us and the insurance company.
- 5) **Medical Calls:** medically qualified personnel need to go on calls if at all possible, The MINIMUM training requirement is CPR certified and know how to use an AED. But if there is a more qualified person at the station, they will need to go. When it is a lift assist, be smart about it and send the appropriate personnel for that kind of call. Be sure and wear your gloves, even for a lift assist, as everything could turn into a bleeding situation.
- 6) **Vern:** fixed the arrow light on Tender 840 as well as switches. There is a master breaker under the truck right over the battery, if the panel does not light up, it is tripped...DO NOT PUSH THE RED BUTTON...there will be a little flag sticking out, that is what you push back in. ******Remember to close all dump switches before you reset the switch. ******
- 7) **Golf Tournament:** We received checks from Ozarka, Golden Eagle and the CNB Team. We still have two outstanding entry fees. After the Awards are paid for, we will net \$21,000 this year!! **Great job everyone.**
- 8) **GOOD NEWS...** Jim (830) has finished his 72-hour introductory training, and is now on Suppression. CONGRATULATIONS JIM
